**A Balancing Act:
Vegetation for Trout Ponds
Saturday, April 18, 1:00-4:00**

While folks avoid planting vegetation in their trout ponds, some vegetation is beneficial in providing shelter from predators, maintaining water temperatures, and providing food. Daniel Redondo from Vermont Wetland Plant Supply will discuss species to plant that are beneficial. In cases where plants become aggressive, David Bryan, an Aquatic Plant Management Contractor will give a perspective on the pros and cons are of controlling plants.

Vermont Wetland Plant Supply is providing us with the majority of herbaceous (non-woody) offerings for this year's tree sale, all of which were chosen specifically for our trout pond owners.

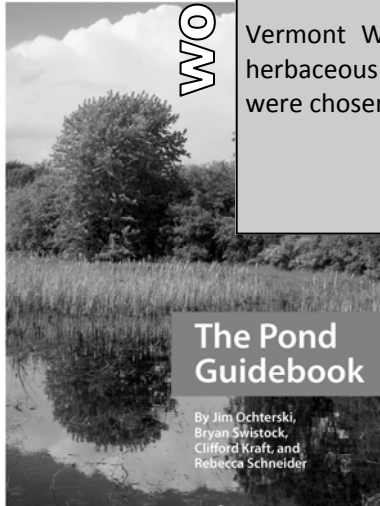
