Nature Camp Behavior Policy

It is our intent to keep all campers safe and maintain a positive group environment. In keeping with this goal, we ask you to work with us to make LCNC's nature camps a positive experience for all our campers by reviewing the following behavior policy and making your child aware of them in an age-appropriate manner.

Campers are expected to act respectfully toward each other and follow camp rules as discussed on the first day of camp.

Unacceptable behavior includes:

- Refusing to follow behavior guidelines or camp rules;
- Using profanity, vulgarity or obscenity;
- Refusal to participate in activities or cooperate with staff;
- Stealing or damaging property (personal or camp property);
- Disrupting a program;
- Leaving the group without permission;
- Endangering the health and safety of campers and/or staff;
- Bullying, hitting or other violent behavior.

Parents or guardians will be informed of inappropriate behavior and contacted to discuss corrective solutions. Camp counselors reserve the right to dismiss a child from camp due to repeated disruptive, violent or dangerous behavior.
